

**Stonehill Community  
Meeting to Preview Siding Colors  
March 7, 2011  
12:30pm**

Present: Donna Slade, Darlene Conzett and Karen Greiner, Color Consultant

The purpose of the meeting was to preview possible siding, trim and decking colors in preparation for residing Building #1. Karen Greiner is a color consultant who works with the contractor.

The group visited several buildings with an extensive color chart attempting to choose those colors which would best suit our community's architectural style. The colors of existing garage and entry doors and the roofs were taken into consideration.

It was found that there are two distinct and different brick colors, one in the pink family and the other more brown. A single color which would coordinate with the two brick colors was not found. Therefore, it was decided to look at those colors which would blend well with each other and also coordinate with the two brick colors. Two colors were suggested: Khaki Brown and Timber Bark. (These colors may be called by different names depending on the sample chart used.)

It was suggested that all trim should be the same color as the siding so as not to accentuate the many differing corners and slopes.

Karen Greiner will obtain larger samples of the chosen colors. The next meeting will be with the Siding and the Architectural committees to get their suggestions and recommendations. After that, the recommended colors will be presented to the board.
